### WHO IS REQUIRED TO HAVE A SINGLE AUDIT?

In accordance with federal requirements, a non-Federal entity (organization) that expends \$750,000 or more in Federal funds from all sources, including USDA's child nutrition programs, during its fiscal year must have a Single Audit or a Program-specific Audit of such Federal funds conducted in accordance with the Federal Office of Management and Budget (OMB) 2 CFR 200 Super Circular. OMB 2 CFR 200 Super Circular further requires that the final audit must be completed and both the reporting package and the data collection form must be submitted to the Federal Audit Clearinghouse (FAC) within the earlier of 30 calendar days after receipt of the auditor's report(s), or nine months after the end of the audit period. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Federal holiday, the reporting package is due the next business day. Unless restricted by Federal statutes or regulations, the auditee must make copies available for public inspection.

## **IMPORTANT DATES & INFORMATION p.2**

When does a copy of your Audit need to be submitted to HCNP? A hard copy is no longer required. Your organization must submit the final audit to the Federal Audit Clearinghouse (FAC) nine months after the end of the audit period or 30 calendar days after the receipt of the auditor's report, whichever is earlier.
