



HAWAII SCHOOL MEALS PROGRAMS
2019 – 2020 Reimbursement Rates
Effective July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020

The Federal rates of reimbursement for School Breakfast Program, National School Lunch Program, Afterschool Snack Program, and Special Milk Program are as follows:

1. School Breakfast Program

	<u>Free</u>	<u>Reduced</u>	<u>Paid</u>
Regular Breakfast	2.15	1.85	.36
Severe Need Breakfast*	2.57	2.27	.36

**Severe Need Breakfast applies to a school that served 40% or more of its lunches as free and reduced in the 2nd preceding year (2017-18).*

2. National School Lunch Program

(The rates in parentheses reflect the 7 cent increase to be paid when menus are certified by HCNP as meeting the new meal pattern requirements)

	<u>Free</u>	<u>Reduced</u>	<u>Paid</u>
Regular Lunch	4.00 (4.07)	3.60 (3.67)	.38 (.45)
Needy Lunch *	4.02 (4.09)	3.62 (3.69)	.40 (.47)

**Needy Lunch rate is paid to those districts that served 60% or more free and reduced lunches in the 2nd preceding year (2017-18).*

3. Afterschool Snack Program

	<u>Free</u>	<u>Reduced</u>	<u>Paid</u>
Sites with less than 50% low income*	1.10	.55	.10
Sites with more than 50% low income*	1.10	N/A	N/A

**50% low income is determined by site using the most recent October Data Report of "area eligible" participants.*

4. Special Milk Program

Milk served to children with approved Free Milk application	Average cost per 1/2 pint of milk
Milk served to all children without Free Milk application	0.2150 per 1/2 pint of milk

5. Commodity Entitlement – The per meal rate PLUS the 12% provision dollars make the effective SY2019-20 NSLP rate 36.25 cents.

6. Maximum Reduced Price Rates for students:

- Breakfast is 30¢ - 7CFR 242.2 Definitions - Reduced price meal
- Lunch is 40¢ - 7CFR 242.2 Definitions - Reduced price meal
- Snack is 15¢ - 7CFR 210.9 (c) (4)
