



Expanded Definition of Disability for CNPs

Revises 'Substantially Limits'

- Need not prevent or severely prevent a major life activity
- ▶ Individualized Assessment
- ▶ Without regard to current disability status
- May include disability that is episodic or in remission





USDA's Expanded Definition

- ▶ Traditionally Recognized Disability Categories:
 - ► Seeing, Hearing, Walking, Speaking, Learning, Reading, Eating, Breathing



- ► Major Bodily Activities:
 - <u>Digestive</u>, Immune, Respiratory, Circulatory, Neurological Systems





Types of Disability Discrimination

- ▶ Denial of benefits or services
- ▶ Delay in receiving benefits or services
- ▶ Different treatment that leads to a disadvantage
- ▶ Ineffective communication
- ▶ Failure to provide reasonable accommodation(s)
- ▶ Inaccessible facilities





Requirements for Reasonable Accommodations

- 'Reasonable Modification': a change or alteration in policies, practices, and/or procedures to accommodate a disability
- ▶ Duty to negotiate
- ► Case-by-case basis
- ▶ Accommodating is primary objective





Requirements for Reasonable Accommodations

- ▶ Handicap accessibility
- ▶ Meal modifications
- ► Accommodations/Modifications addressed in 504, Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- ▶ Accommodations need not be exactly as requested
- ▶ Provided free of charge
- ► Contact HCNP if further guidance needed






Procedural Safeguards

- SFAs required to provide notice and information to parents and guardians regarding how to request a reasonable modification, including the right to:
 - ▶ File a grievance
 - ▶ Receive a prompt response
 - ► An impartial hearing
 - ▶ Be represented by counsel
 - ▶ Receive notice of final decision
















Sponsor Complaint Procedure, Log, and Form

▶ Written Civil Rights Complaint Procedure	
▶ Annually dated Civil Rights Complaint Log	
▶ Copies of Civil Rights Complaint Forms	











SFA Checklist (continued) Maintain Civil Rights Complaint Log Include non-discrimination statement on all printed materials related to school nutrition programs Keep all records for 3 years plus the current year (6 years plus current for HIDOE)







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
