SUBJECT: Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 National School Lunch Program Equipment Assistance

Grants for SFAs – Request for Application (RFA)

Applications Due: Friday, January 21, 2022, by 4:30 p.m. (received by email, postmarked, or walked-in)

The Hawaii Child Nutrition Programs (HCNP) has been allocated \$99,462 to competitively award equipment assistance grants to eligible SFAs participating in the NSLP.

These funds will allow SFAs to purchase equipment needed to serve healthier meals, improve food safety, to help support the establishment, maintenance, or expansion of the School Breakfast Program, and other improvements. Funds will be disbursed to the SFA after all the supporting documents are approved. Equipment cannot be purchased prior to your SFA receiving and accepting the award letter. SFAs who are awarded grants are required to purchase the equipment and submit supporting documents to HCNP after receipt of the equipment to receive reimbursements.

Priority is given to SFAs with severe need schools (i.e. schools in underserved areas, schools with limited access to other resources, and age of food service equipment) where 50 percent or more of the enrolled students are eligible for free or reduced-price meals. In addition, priority is given to schools that have not received any, or might not have received a recent, NSLP Equipment Assistance Grant award under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and the FY 2010, FY 2013, FY 2014, FY 2015, FY 2016, FY 2017, FY 2018, FY 2019 and FY 2020 Agriculture Appropriations Acts.

The following Criteria/Focus areas for equipment will be given consideration for the award selection:

- > Age/condition of current food service equipment or lack of appropriate equipment
- > Availability of existing State and local funding to the SFA for equipment purchases
- Strategies for adopting lunchroom changes that provide more convenience and appeal to the student population
- Opportunities to realize meaningful impact on nutrition and quality of meals
- > Allows the SFA to improve or expand participation in its lunch program and School Breakfast Program (SBP)
- Facilitates the service and/or enjoyment of meals in a school's meal service that has accommodated COVID-19 prevention policies

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Equipment requests may include new equipment, renovation of equipment, or replacement of equipment. Regulations at 2 CFR Part 200.33 defines equipment as tangible nonexpendable personal property having a useful life of more than one year and a per-unit acquisition cost of \$5,000 or more; or a lesser amount if authorized by the SFA.

For the 2021 NSLP Equipment Assistance Grants, Congress has specified that the threshold for the purchase for equipment will be \$1,000 and above.

SFAs submitting applications for their sites must follow all Federal, State, and local procurement laws when purchasing equipment with NSLP equipment grant funds. Additionally, SFAs must indicate on the enclosed application form (Section 5-F) that procurement and expenditure activities will be completed within 9 months of receiving the award notification.
