



HAWAII SCHOOL MEALS PROGRAMS 2022 – 2023 Reimbursement Rates Effective July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023

The Federal rates of reimbursement for School Breakfast Program, National School Lunch Program, Afterschool Snack Program, and Special Milk Program are as follows:

1. School Breakfast Program¹

	<u>Free</u>	<u>Reduced</u>	<u>Paid</u>
Regular Breakfast	2.61	2.31	.55
Severe Need Breakfast*	3.09	2.79	.55

*Severe Need Breakfast applies to a school that served 40% or more of its lunches as free and reduced in the 2nd preceding year (2020-21).

2. National School Lunch Program¹

(The rates in parentheses reflect the 8 cents increase to be paid when menus are certified by HCNP as meeting the new meal pattern requirements)

	<u>Free</u>	<u>Reduced</u>	<u>Paid</u>
Regular Lunch	5.00 (5.08)	4.60 (4.68)	.84 (.92)
Needy Lunch *	5.02 (5.10)	4.62 (4.70)	.86 (.94)

*Needy Lunch rate is paid to those districts that served 60% or more free and reduced lunches in the 2nd preceding year (2020-21).

3. Afterschool Snack Program

	<u>Free</u>	<u>Reduced</u>	<u>Paid</u>
Sites with less than 50% low income*	1.26	.63	.11
Sites with more than 50% low income*	1.26	N/A	N/A

*50% low income is determined by site using the most recent October Data Report of "area eligible" participants.

4. Special Milk Program

Milk served to children with approved Free Milk application	Average cost per 1/2 pint of milk
Milk served to all children without Free Milk application	0.2700 per 1/2 pint of milk

5. Commodity Entitlement – The per meal rate (30.00 cents) PLUS the 12% provision dollars and the 20M breakfast dollars for NSLP make the effective SY 2022 - 2023 NSLP rate 43.00 cents.

6. Maximum Reduced Price Rates for students:

- Breakfast is 30¢ - 7CFR 242.2 Definitions - Reduced price meal
- Lunch is 40¢ - 7CFR 242.2 Definitions - Reduced price meal
- Snack is 15¢ - 7CFR 210.9 (c) (4)

¹The Keep Kids Fed Act of 2022 provides an additional 40 cents for each lunch served and allows an additional 15 cents for each breakfast served for the school year starting July 1, 2022 ending on June 30, 2023
