At-Risk Afterschool Area Eligibility


Allows afterschool care centers, regardless of location, to serve at-risk afterschool meals and snacks





Non-Congregate Feeding

- Allows meals to be provided outside of congregate feeding setting
 - Can be picked up at a designated site or delivered to homes





Meal Service Times

Allows meals to be served outside of standard meal times





Meal Pattern Flexibility

Waives requirement to serve meals that meet the meal pattern requirements



Parent/Guardian Meal Pick Up

Allows parent or guardian to pick up meals for children

Plan to ensure accountability and program integrity is required
